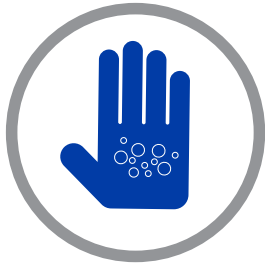


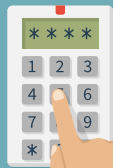
GERMIEST PLACES ON A COLLEGE CAMPUS

BACTERIA

High-touch surfaces like **microwave touch screens and door buttons** are often contaminated by uncooked foods that leave behind bacteria like *E.coli* and *Salmonella*.
